**COVID -19 RISK ASSESSMENT AND UPDATED COVID-19 GUIDANCE**  
**BUILDBASE FA TROPHY GAMES AND NPL GAMES POST**

**17 DECEMBER 2021**

With the current **OMICRON** variant causing daily cases of over 80000 the FA have outlined restrictions to partner along with the previous guidance by the FA and DCMS. This includes updated guidance for FA Trophy games. Along with this FA updated protocols MTFC have updated their current RA (Item 2 below). The MTFC RA below enhances previous guidance and should be read in conjunction with previous guides and protocol taking into account this updated version

1	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus All MTFC Staff All MTFC Volunteers All Spectators All Visitors	<b><u>BUILDBASE FA Trophy Covid-19 Update 15/12/21:</u></b> The DCMS and the FA have updated guidance and Protocols and have issued new guidance. This includes the legal requirement to wear a face covering in indoor venues of open stadiums. In accordance with item 7 of the update signage is displayed around the stadium recommending masks in seated areas. Stewards are to remind attendees of Covid symptom awareness. Stewards are briefed on social distancing awareness. Track and Trace is available and is promoted. In conjunction with MTFC H&S policy areas of Serial 9 are applied. The stadium dressing rooms and social club are to be deep cleaned and Fogged. Non-vaccinated Players/Staff will be tested on match days. A designated warm up area for officials will be designated. Social distancing is to be applied in the changing rooms where only those starting are to be briefed. Teams are to enter and leave the field separately and social distancing is to be applied in the technical area. Players and Management are reminded not to confront match officials. Previous MTFC guidance and protocols apply.
