This version 2 of Players/Managers Training and Match Day Protocol Covid-19 Plan is an updated Covid-19 guide from the initial guidelines and briefing on Thursday 23 July with Matlock Town Manager and Assistant Manager and members of Matlock Town management committee regarding Covid-19 guidance for Management and Players

This updated version amends certain parts of sections (9/11/13) of version 4 of the current Ground Guidance

1	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus  Travel to training Players/Manager	Players should not car share/Players should travel independently If they must travel together it should be the same person each time Keep windows open/Sit as far away from each other as possible Wear face coverings/PPE/Apply Covid-19 guidance Monitor themselves for Covid-19 symptoms	Players Manager SO
2	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus Welfare	Bring own personal water bottle which is labelled Arrive changed ready to train avoid changing rooms where possible Bibs should only be worn if necessary and only worn once and not swapped	Players Manager SO Kit Man
3	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus Equipment	Bibs Balls cones goalpost etc must be regularly wiped down Cleaned before during (where touched) and after each session Players should be aware of the ball transfer system for balls out of the playing area during match days Opposition players are to be briefed accordingly as should the Match Officials	Kit Man Players Manager

4	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus Changing Rooms	Changing rooms should socially distance at this moment where practical Players should leave training in the kit they arrived Where changing rooms area are used players should stagger the use to apply social distancing as much as possible Players should leave the changing rooms as clean as possible Players playing strips should be turned the correct way around and placed in black plastic bags ready for volunteers to wash. 5	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus All Match Day personnel including Volunteers and spectators	The match day risk assessment is covered in the Ground Guidance Plan. However certain areas have been up dated when the ground was opened to spectators.	Covid-19 Officer when the season starts
6	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus All Match Day personnel Volunteers and spectators	Match day dugout protocols are to be observed by keeping one seat apart from the next player/trainer/substitute. Where this is not possible players/substitute are to use the front row of the Twigg stand remaining one seat apart and wearing a Face covering at all times	Players Managers Volunteers Committee Members
7	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus All Match Day personnel Volunteers and spectators	Managers and Players should be continually aware of the need for social distancing particularly where Coach travel is involved. Where travel is required Managers/Players/Committee members are to wear face coverings and maintain social distancing where practicable. They should be particularly aware of victory celebrations that could easily compromise social distancing requirements.	Players Managers Volunteers Coach Company Committee Members
8	Transmission of Covid-19 Virus All Match Day personnel Volunteers and spectators	The Team Management should continue to carry out Training Session Covid-19 checks (Attached) and ensure Players are aware of the need to check for symptoms prior to Match Days	Team Management
