COVID -19 RISK ASSESSMENT POST 19 JULY 2021 GUIDE 'WORKING SAFELY'

16 JULY 2021

From 19 July 2021 almost all requirements of Covid-19 restrictions will be lifted. However responsible employers providers of services entertainment establishments sports arenas food and alcohol establishments should ensure that although 'Personal Decisions' are now required, guidance on good hygiene and prevention of the spread of the virus is to be promoted
The following in conjunction with the previous Covid-19 Risk Assessments from 2020 and 2021 is the recommended guide that the Club will 'So Far as is reasonably practicable' (SFARP) apply to current guidance. All Club Committee Members and Stewards are encouraged to promote this advice and guidance where practicable

Prevent customers leaning on counters or screens where possible. Where possible waiter service and the use of contactless payments will be applied. Continue to 'Fog' on a regular basis</p> <p>Toilet Facilities: Display hand washing signs and ensure that soap and drying of hands facilities are available</p> <p>Track and Trace: QR codes are displayed externally at the entrance and within the stadium. Hard copies are available at the Social Club</p> <p>Covid Symptoms: Signage asking visitors not to attend if showing symptoms. MTFC staff and all those associated with MTFC should apply the same criteria. Where possible test regularly and self-isolate. Visitors displaying obvious symptoms and are in the ground will be asked to leave by a Committee Member</p> <p>Enforcement: None of the above is legally enforceable however MTFC will carry out the above post Covid-19 protocols for the foreseeable future SFARP</p> <p>Players: It may be worth considering both teams entering the pitch separately should other teams have concerns when the season starts</p>	Club Exec Committee Committee Members Ground Secretary Club Safety Officer Bar Steward Tea Shop Manager
